FRIDA KAHLO IN THE CLASSROOM

Our last Fine Arts Mini Experience (F.A.M.E.) session was a huge success! We selected Frida Kahlo and had all the kids draw self-portraits in her unique style of painting.

We would love to conduct these sessions once a month, but we need parents to step up and volunteer just ONE hour a month. This is how a typical FAME session is conducted:

- Pick up supplies and artist write-up from Library
- One volunteer reads prepared write-up about artist/art form while the other volunteer distributes the supplies (5-7 minutes)
- Kids draw/paint/create for 35 minutes
- Collect drawing materials and kids clean up (5-7 minutes)
- · Return supplies and artist write-up to library

In less than an hour you've helped expose the kids to a new artist and allowed them to create their own masterpieces, and have a lot of fun! We just need two volunteers to select a day and time of their convenience (approved by the teacher) and be a F.A.M.E.-ous hero in their kid's class!
