END OF YEAR MEDICATIONS AT

SCHOOL

INFORMATION—Please save these dates!

The first day of school for the 2018-2019 School Year is Wednesday, August 29, 2018. You will find out your child's teacher and classroom assignment at our MAZE Days which are scheduled to be held on Tuesday, August 21st for TK, Kindergarten and 1st Grade students and Wednesday, August 22nd for students in grades 2 – 6.

The MAZE Day Schedule is attached to this newsletter. The purpose of MAZE Days is for the parents to turn in all their 1st Day Packet Emergency Paperwork prior to school starting so we can prepare for your child to attend Brookvale. For confidentiality reasons, class lists will not be posted for parents to view. Please schedule your summer vacation plans so as to be present during MAZE Days.

If you miss your child's scheduled MAZE Day, you will be able to turn in your paperwork and pick up your child's assignment the day before school begins or the first day of school only. Only a parent or legal guardian may turn in the paperwork and obtain the student's class assignment.

*Parents have the option to pay for Annual Round Trip and Annual One Way passes in ten (10) monthly installments:

Annual Round Trip = \$77.00/month Annual One Way = \$44.00/month

Bus passes for 2018-2019 may be purchased online or in person at the Transportation Department beginning August 1, 2018. It is recommended that parents purchase bus passes online or plan their office visits for early August to avoid the last minute crowds. Passes may be purchased in person at the Transportation Department office, located at 43770 S. Grimmer Blvd. Bus passes may be purchased between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Online payment may be made by using the myschoolbucks.com portal.

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL & REASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS

The 2018-2019 School Year begins on Wednesday, August 29, 2018. All students are expected to report to school on the first day, Wednesday, August 29, 2018, unless they are ill. Students who have not attended the first day of school may be transferred to another school effective the second day of school if classrooms at the school of original enrollment are filled. Parents must call in their child's absence and notify the school that their child is ill in order to save their seat. Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.
