NOTE: Each student can register for only one performance. Performance time limit: 1.5 min to 2 min only.

MUST SUBMIT AT REGISTRATION: PERFORMANCE CATEGORY, LYRICS, AND NAME OF SONG/MUSIC IF APPLICABLE. IF LYRICS ARE NOT IN ENGLISH, PLEASE SUBMIT TRANSLATED ENGLISH MEANING.

Important Dates: Participants and Emcees MUST be present for ALL FOUR dates, for their ENTIRE session time.

- 1. Wednesday, March 11, 2020 Audition for Grades TK-2 1:30-2:15pm, for Grades 3-6 2:30-3:15pm
- 2. Wednesday, March 18, 2020 Rehearsal 1:30-3:00pm
- 3. Friday, March 20, 2020 Talent Show Family Performance 6:00-7:30pm
- 4. Wednesday, March 25, 2020 Talent Show School Assembly (For students and staff only.)

For group performance - the maximum group size is limited to 6 participants.

Registration does not automatically qualify you for the audition. Audition is not a guarantee of final selection. Entries will be reviewed in the order received and selected to ensure variety and grade level participation. If selected to proceed for audition, we will email you the necessary details for audition separately.

IMPORTANT: **Emcee** Information - Open to **Sixth Grade students ONLY.** Please follow the same registration process. Students will have to work separately with Talent Show Chair/Director on emcee prep/script for about 2 hrs about 10-14 days before audition. Instructions will be emailed separately to the concerned students.
